

<p>On Friday, December 7, 2007, the AMPTP, as agent for its represented employers, interfered with, restrained, and coerced employees in the exercise of their rights under Section 7 of the National Labor Relations Act and failed and refused to bargain in good faith with the collective bargaining representatives of the employers' writers by unlawfully refusing to schedule negotiations with charging parties Writers Guild of America, West, Inc. and Writers Guild of America, East, Inc. (jointly "WGA") to bargain for a successor collective bargaining agreement, unless and until the WGA withdraws specific proposals.</p>		
<p><b>By the above and other acts, the above-named employer has interfered with, restrained, and coerced employees in the exercise of the rights guaranteed in Section 7 of the Act.</b></p>
